

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-10**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APOPKA, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2019 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020, PROVIDING FOR A BUDGET AMENDMENT

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Apopka, Florida, has determined that the Budget for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 should be amended; and

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statutes, Section 166.241(4) requires the governing body amend the budgets in the same manner as the original budget is adopted; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted the final budgets for fiscal year 2019/2020 through resolution on September 18, 2019.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APOPKA, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** That the Budget for the City of Apopka, Florida, and Fiscal Year 2019/2020 is hereby amended for an amount totaling \$48,465 as indicated in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and made part of this Resolution by reference.

**SECTION 2:** Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon final passage and adoption.

<p><b>This budget amendment includes changes in funding and appropriations related to the award of Federal funds from the US Department of Justice (USDOJ) to help prevent, prepare, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic. The funds are going to be used to purchase sanitization equipment and supplies for distribution throughout all city-owned facilities. This will include a large number of disinfectant cleaners and wipes, portable and fixed sanitizer stations, and sanitizer station refill solution. We will also purchase two (2) "Whole Room" Pulsed Zenon light units for sterilization of city facilities and two (2) "Mobile" Pulsed Zenon light units for sterilization of city vehicles; such as police cars and ambulances. There is no match requirement for the awarded funds.</b></p>
